ADR: CONCERT FOR PASSENGERS OF 111 YOUNG TALENTS FROM THE SANTA CECILIA ACADEMY IN FIUMICINO TERMINAL 3

- The orchestra was conducted by Vanessa Benelli Mosell, the internationally renowned young conductor chosen as testimonial for the Mundys campaign
- For the first time ever, a full orchestra performed a concert for the passengers at the airport.

Fiumicino, 16 March 2023 - Extraordinary performance at Fiumicino airport by the JuniOrchestra of the Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia of Rome, composed of 111 young people and conducted by Maestro Vanessa Benelli Mosell, testimonial of the communication campaign for the launch of Mundys, the new infrastructure reality shareholder of Adr.

The event, opened by the President of Mundys, Giampiero Massolo, together with the President of Adr, Claudio De Vincenti, was attended by several hundred passengers, who welcomed with great favour and interest the performance of the young orchestras inside the international boarding area E at Terminal 3, built according to the most advanced technologies and the best standards of environmental protection.

The programme selected for the event featured performances of some of the best-known compositions by Ravel, Borodin, Bernstein and other internationally renowned composers. The concert lasted about an hour, opened with 'Danze polovesiane' by Aleksandr Borodin, followed by, among other pieces, Leonard Bernstein's West Side Story, and closing with Maurice Ravel's Bolero. The 111-piece orchestra consisted of, among others, 27 violins, 14 cellos, 9 flutes, 1 piano, 8 trumpets, 4 trombones, 8 percussionists. The Leonardo da Vinci was thus transformed for one evening into a large and innovative auditorium where outstanding artists performed in a unique concert for the audience and intercontinental passengers present.

The conductor of the orchestra, Vanessa Benelli Mosell, is an internationally renowned artist: she has performed in prestigious concert halls, such as the Berliner Philharmonie, the Laeiszhalle in Hamburg, the Auditorio Nacional in Madrid, the Auditorium du Louvre in Paris, the Dublin National Concert Hall, the Seoul Arts Centre, the Beijing National Centre for the Performing Arts, the Royal Festival Hall and Kings Place in London, and La Scala in Milan.

Aeroporti di Roma, an Mundys Group company, manages and develops the Rome Fiumicino and Ciampino airports and carries out other activities related and complementary to airport management. Fiumicino, the first and only airport in Italy with a Skytrax rating of 5 stars for excellent standards in service quality, has two passenger terminals and is dedicated to business and leisure customers on domestic, international and intercontinental routes; Ciampino is mainly used by low-cost airlines, express-couriers and General Aviation activities. As an airport system, ADR recorded 49.4 million passengers in 2019. (In 2022, following the effects induced by Covid - 19 on air transport, Fiumicino airport recorded around 29.4 million passengers while Ciampino airport closed the year with 3.5 million passengers). Over the past five years, Aeroporti di Roma has received numerous awards, recognitions and quality certificates. The main ones are the AIRPORT SERVICE QUALITY AWARD, awarded by ACI World for the category of European airports with over 40 million passengers per year, for the years 2017 to 2022 for the high level of passenger satisfaction, and the ACI EUROPE BEST AIRPORT AWARD, category of airports with over 40 million passengers per year, for the years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2022: the award, in this case, rewards the achievement of excellence in several disciplines, including security, operations, infrastructure, community relations, environmental awareness and customer care. As a result of these achievements, ACI World included ADR in the 'Director General's Roll of Excellence' in 2022. This is a roll of excellence to which only 69 out of more than 18,000 airports worldwide belong for the very high levels of quality offered to their passengers. In 2018, SKYTRAX awarded ADR as the WORLD'S MOST IMPROVED AIRPORT based on the evaluation of services





experienced by passengers at various airports around the world. In 2022, ADR again received the BEST AIRPORT STAFF IN EUROPE AWARD from Skytrax for meeting precise parameters of friendliness and efficiency of customer service staff in the terminal. Also in the field of sustainability, ADR distinguished itself by receiving the LEADERSHIP IN SUSTAINABILITY AND COMMITMENT TO RESPONSIBLE TRAVEL in 2020 from the United Nations World Tourism Organisation. In the field of innovation, ADR was awarded the ACI EUROPE DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION AWARD in 2021, linked to the SESAR - Single European Sky project, for the airport's investment in the brand new Airport Operation Centre and for the implementation of the new innovation model focused on Open Innovation. In 2022, Plug and Play Tech Center, the largest private investment fund in Silicon Valley, awarded ADR the "Corporate Innovation Award" for its commitment to promoting open innovation initiatives and building an innovative "airport of the future".
