For the fifth year running it has been included in the Dow Jones Sustainability World Index, which ranks the best enterprises in the world based on economic, environmental and social criteria. As in the previous year, the Group ranks number one in the global transport and infrastructure sector in terms of Fuel Efficiency, Operational Eco-efficiency and Human Capital Development.
