## MUNDYS: CDP REAFFIRMS TOP RATING AMONG ALMOST 25,000 FIRMS SURVEYED

Recognition for our governance and climate action plan

Rome, 6 March 2025 - Mundys's sustainability leadership has been reaffirmed, once again placing us in the prestigious "A-list" drawn up by CDP, the leading global organisation for assessing companies' climate and environmental performance. The achievement is reward for Group companies' ongoing commitment to driving delivery of a decarbonisation strategy that includes over 150 initiatives targeting reductions in greenhouse gas emissions and managing the risks linked to climate change. In terms of business strategy, this translates into investment in the energy efficiency and transition of infrastructure, in the large-scale introduction of LED lighting, the replacement of heating and cooling systems, electrification of our vehicle fleets, the deployment of solar power plants across the infrastructure we manage and the installation of electric vehicle charging points. All of this has enabled Mundys to position itself as a global leader among the more than 24,800 firms surveyed, receiving the highest possible "A" rating on a scale from "D-" to "A".

This achievement forms part of a roadmap that includes certification of our CO2 emission reduction targets by SBTi (Science Based Targets Initiative) and involvement in international working groups focusing on decarbonization of the transport sector and sustainability-linked finance.

Mundys was one of the first companies in Italy to adopt a Climate Action Plan to help drive the energy transition and decarbonise economic activity throughout the value chain for airports, motorway and mobility services. This has involved setting clear, concrete targets, including a commitment to cutting net direct (Scope 1 & 2) emissions to zero by 2040. The rating also comes soon after the recent opening by Aeroporti di Roma, a Mundys subsidiary, of the new solar farm at Fiumicino airport. The largest photovoltaic self-consumption plant at a European airport, this is a key component of the Group's climate action plan and demonstrates how the plan is being effectively and progressively implemented.
