PRELIMINARY TRAFFIC FIGURES FOR NINE MONTHS ENDED 30

SEPTEMBER 2016

Rome, 17 October 2016 - Preliminary traffic figures for the network operated under

concession by the Group's Italian motorway operators show growth of 3.5% during the first

nine months of 2016, compared with the same period of 2015. A breakdown shows that the

number of kilometres travelled by vehicles with "2 axles" (cars and vans) is up 3.4%, whilst

vehicles with 3 or more axles registered growth of 4.4%.

Motorway traffic on the network operated by the Group's overseas subsidiaries is up 1.9%

overall; more in depth, motorway traffic is up 6.2% in Chile, whilst the Group's Brazilian

operators have seen a reduction of 2.7%, linked to the continuing weakness of the

country's economy.

Aeroporti di Roma handled 36.2m passengers in the first nine months of 2016,

registering overall growth of 1.7% compared with the same period of 2015.
